Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is unable to compete, absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. No entry fees returned after February 11, 2009. Only corrections as allowed by the AKC rules may be applied if informed according to the rules schedule. Refunds of \$3.00 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. No entry fee will be refunded if the events cannot be open or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

ALL PARTICIPANTS INFORMATION

SSCA and Triple Crown assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Free parking is available for all exhibitors and spectators. Park at your own risk. All dogs MUST be on leash or confined when not being judged. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refunds of any fees shall be made.

Building access is 8am to 7pm all equipment and dogs must be removed by 7pm on Sunday. Conformation ring will be inside the building. Crating areas will be defined and available on a first come first serve basis. Dogs may not be left overnight at the building. Plenty of crating space inside.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. No form of verbal or physical abuse of a dog will be tolerated.

Triple Crown Rules

Unauthorized access to Triple Crown kennel areas is strictly prohibited. Unauthorized access to the sports field in front of the office building is prohibited. Triple Crown staff works hard to maintain a clean facility. We appreciate your help in picking up after yourself, as well as your pets. No dogs are allowed in the indoor restrooms or kitchen area.
