A qualifying score is required for all prizes in regular obedience classes. A dark green ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a qualifying score. Please Note: No entry fees will be refunded to bitches entered in the Obedience Trial that come into season after entries close.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
