(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is unable to compete, absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. No entry fees returned after April 14th, 2010. Only corrections as allowed by the AKC rules may be applied if informed according to the rules schedule. Refunds of \$3.00 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. No entry fee will be refunded if the events cannot be open or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

ALL PARTICIPANTS INFORMATION

SSCA and Triple Crown assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Free parking is available for all exhibitors and spectators. Park at your own risk. All dogs MUST be on leash or confined when not being judged. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refunds of any fees shall be made.

Building access is 8 am to 7pm all equipment and dogs must be removed by 7pm on Sunday. Conformation ring will be inside the building. Crating areas will be defined and available on a first come first serve basis. Dogs may not be left overnight at the building.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. No form of verbal or physical abuse of a dog will be tolerated.

Triple Crown Rules
